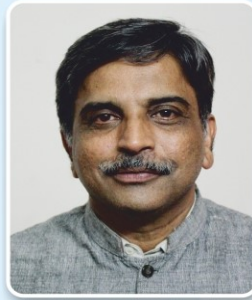

## **INFRASTRUCTURE & AMENITIES**

We, *G. S. College of Commerce, Wardha* are truly committed to provide a holistic environment conducive to learning and to inculcate the moral values to strengthen spirituality. *The 6.6 acre pleasing campus* is a single faculty, grant-in aid, co-educational college affiliated to RTM University, Nagpur. The college has the substantial infrastructure required for sports activities like basketball, Football, Kabbadi, Floorball, Korfbal, Table-Tennis, Tug of War, Ball Badminton, Volleyball, Badminton, Yoga, Fencing, Weightlifting, etc. The college has excellent infrastructure and learning resources including ICT enabled classrooms, seminar halls, fully equipped computer laboratories, smart board and other amenities to serve the needs of students and faculty.

The college has green campus spread over *an area of 26709 sq.mt + 1757 sq.mt (MBA Building)*. The total available build up space is 5,754.10 sq.mt. + 1757 sq.mt (MBA Building) There are three buildings including Department of Advanced Management studies for regular academic and administrative activities with an adequate facility for teaching - learning. viz., classrooms, laboratories, computing equipment. The college is well-equipped with the physical and technology-enabled infrastructure that supports the existing academic programs and administration.

There are sufficient number of UPS's for ensuring power backup. The college maintains an adequate student computer ratio (9:1) with 100 Mbps bandwidth internet connection and campus Wi-Fi facility. The college has established Annual Maintenance Contracts (AMC) with different vendors/ firms for maintaining physical, academic and support facilities. The College has 27 well-furnished class rooms out of which 13 ICT enabled. Commerce Lab with LAN and secured Wi-Fi facility is accessible to the commerce students to develop the Knowledge for Commerce Projects and Competitive Examinations.

In Gymkhana, there is a well-equipped in-door hall for the development of students' sports skills and fitness so as to help the students for participation in national and international competitions. Till date many of our students achieved success in various national and international competitions. The College has a facility of Girls Hostel with the capacity of 50 students and for girls. Residential facility is also provided by the college for teaching staff- 02 blocks and non-teaching staff - 03 blocks. The entire infrastructure is under CCTV surveillance.

## ABOUT Hindi Linguistic Minority

As per Government decision (R - 8133/13), the college has been given the status of *The Hindi Linguistic Minority Institute*. Therefore, students seeking admission to G.S. College of Commerce, Wardha are given admission as per the following rules and regulations:-

- Out of the total grant courses seats, 50% seats are reserved for Hindi as mother tongue students, have domiciled in Maharashtra.
- Out of the total non-grant courses seats, 51 % seats are reserved for Hindi as mother tongue students.
- Admission for the above mention reserved seats will be strictly on merit basis.
- Non-minority seats are filled in accordance with State Govt. Reservation rules.
- If Minority seats are not filled up to cut off date, admissions are granted to non-minority students on merit basis as per notified programme.
- Minority students have to produce evidence of belonging to Hindi as mother tongue group / community- Student have to produce any evidence / proof with a declaration form of belonging to a Hindi as mother tongue group/community on a stamp paper worth Rs- 20/-

**Guidelines for the Issuance of Books**

1. A student will be provided two BT's for issuance book from the library.
2. BT is Non-transferable. Transferring self BT to other is a punishable offence.
3. Book will be issued to the valid BT holder only.
4. Valid ID card is compulsory for issuing the books from the library.
5. Books will be issued for a week and can be renewed for further week. If a student does not renew the book or return the book after the due date will charge a late fee Rupees 1/day.
6. Students must check the book on issuing at counter; if the book is found mutilated or torn pages the student must inform the library staff on the circulation counter, otherwise the borrower will be held responsible for the same.
7. If it is found that book is lost or damaged the borrower must replace it with a new copy of the Book or have to pay the amount of the book with the fine as per the college, library authority, rules and regulations.
8. Handle the library book carefully and return the books on due date or renewed otherwise fine will be charged at the time of clearance.
