Manuscripts Submission Guidelines for ISBN Edited Book:

- Authors are encouraged to submit their manuscripts adhering to our guidelines:
- Authors are free to select any topic that is related to the given broad themes. The chapter may be in the form of case study, review, empirical study or conceptual Study, etc. The abstract should not be more than 200 words with at least three key words. The first page of the manuscript should have the title of the paper, name of the author, organizational affiliation, phone number and E-mail address.
- In the covering letter accompanying the manuscript, the authors should certify that the manuscript has neither been published nor considered anywhere for publication. Tables, Illustrations, Charts and figures should be serially numbered and acknowledged with source of data.
- Length of full paper should not be more than 3000 words. (Including abstract)
- The manuscript should be in MS Word document, Times New Roman Font, Justify alignment, 1.5 line spacing, APA Style of referencing should be used.
- Using SHREE-DEV7-0716/ Unicode font for Hindi or Marathi manuscript. The chapter will publish in ISBN Book "Sporting Revival: Health, Harmony, Glory" (Multidisciplinary)
- The Plagiarism rate (Similarity Index) should under 10%
