

The primary objective of **GS-UDAAN** is to provide a premier, competitive platform that enhances the academic and practical skills of students across different educational levels, fostering intellectual growth and promoting healthy rivalry. The 2025 edition saw enthusiastic participation across November 25th and 26th.

The two-day **GS-UDAAN** event featured competitions for Standard IX and X students on November 25th, followed by Junior College (Standard XI & XII) level events on November 26th.



The event on November 25th focused on competitions for Standard IX and X students drawing participation from 14 schools with 56 school students. These younger participants showcased their capabilities in three events: **the Spell Bee Competition, the Essay Competition and the Poster Presentation Competition**. 
प्राचार्यांकितून कौतुकाची थाप

The All India NCC Girls Trekking Expedition - 2025 was a national-level adventure camp organized by the National Cadet Corps (NCC) specifically for girl cadets from across the country. The trek was conducted in Tamil Nadu, primarily within the scenic Nilgiris mountain range. The expedition was managed by the NCC Group Coimbatore under the supervision of the NCC Directorate (TN, P&AN) (Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Andaman Nicobar). Cadet Ruchika Balapure of G.S. College, Wardha, representing the Maharashtra Directorate, successfully completed the expedition. The official certificate was issued in Ooty the famous hill station in the Nilgiris, on 11 May 2025.

Cadet Tanu Vinodrao Babhulkar (All India Adventure Camp: Rock Climbing Training Camp, Gwalior)



This was a prestigious national-level All India Adventure Camp (Rock Climbing Training Camp) held at the Group Headquarter in Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh, and organized by the 3 MP Girls Battalion. Cdt. Siddhant Ajay Parimal and Cdt Suraj Sheshrao Jadhav selected in Indian Army (Para special force commando)


