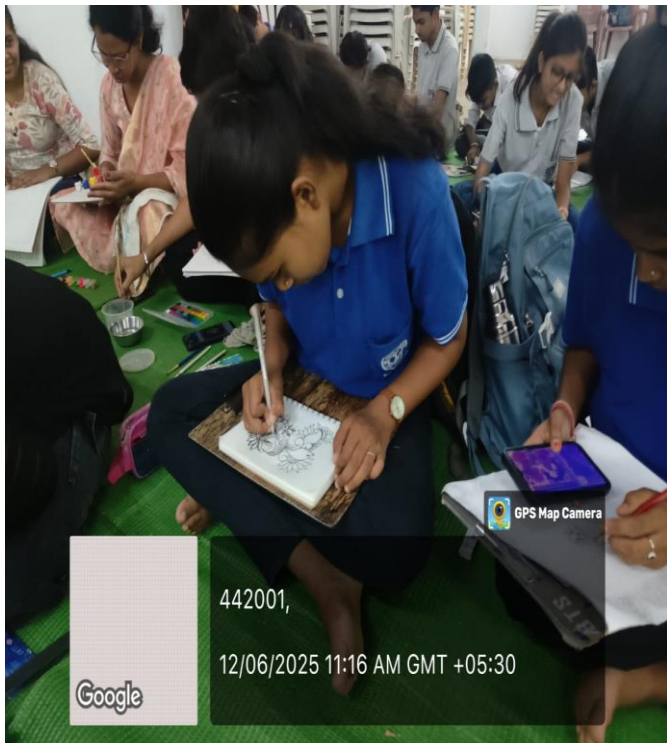

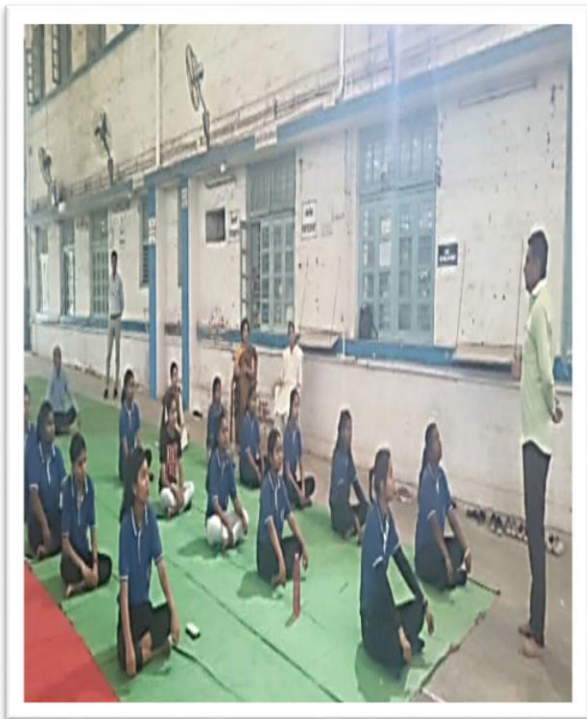
INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY (21/06/2025)

ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

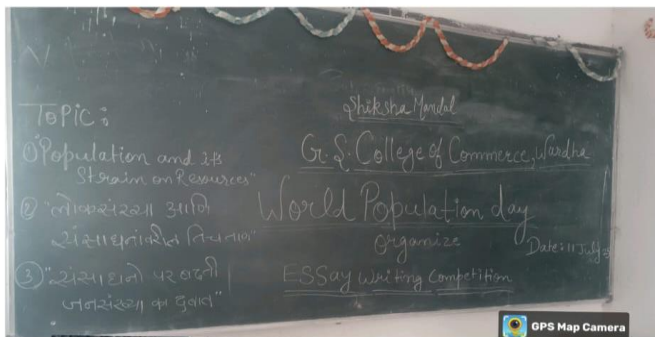
FOR NEW STUDENTS ABOUT INTRODUCTION TO NSS (28-07-2025)

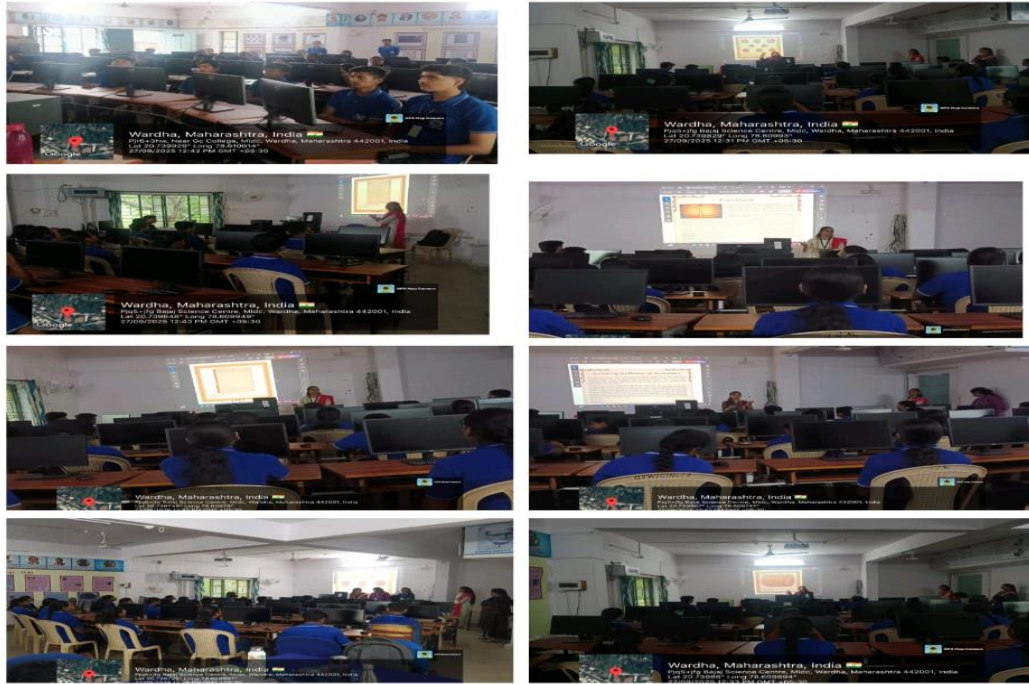

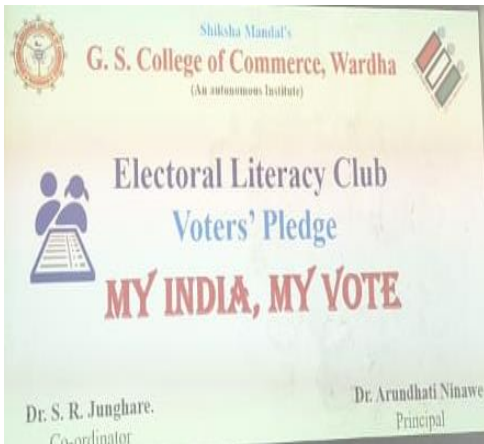
Cleanliness (23-01-2026)

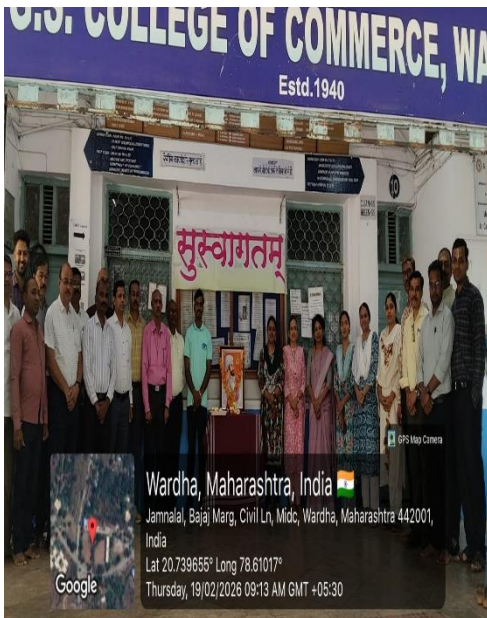
Pariksha Pe Charcha Session Video (06-02-26)
