**वर्धा (युसूफ पठाण)** । विदर्भातील अग्रगण्य वाणिज्य शिक्षण संस्था म्हणून ओळख असलेल्या गोविंदराम सेक्सरिया वाणिज्य महाविद्यालय, वर्धा यांनी आपल्या 85 वर्षांच्या गौरवशाली शैक्षणिक परंपरेत आणखी एक मानाचा तुरा रोवला आहे. महाविद्यालयाच्या कनिष्ठ महाविद्यालय (वाणिज्य विभाग) ला महाराष्ट्र राज्य शैक्षणिक संशोधन व प्रशिक्षण परिषद (SCERT) यांच्या स्कूल गुणवत्ता मूल्यांकन व हमी आराखडा (SQAAC) अंतर्गत प्रतिष्ठित 'A+' दर्जा प्रदान करण्यात आला आहे.
